Our education programmes are central to the Reza ethos. Despite the Covid crisis we've continued to develop our work, offering educational programmes to both mainstream and educational needs schools.

We've been running interactive projects and concerts for over three years with Ingfield Manor; a school for pupils with neurological motor impairments.

Our virtual project in Autumn 2020 included creative music making workshops, teacher training and online resources and an Ensemble Reza concert.
